It comes with one of the world's most expensive foods and a contribution to a worthy cause. This one-of-a-kind bagel features Alba white truffle cream cheese and goji berry infused Riesling jelly with golden leaves. Pound for pound, the white truffle is the second most expensive food in the world, next to caviar. Guests need not worry on how much to tip on this four-digit bagel, tax and gratuity are included and it is available via 24-hour room service or during breakfast hours (7:00 to 11:00 am) in Foundry Kitchen.

Serious thought was put into the creation of the city's first outrageous bagel to ensure the hefty price tag doesn't just get patrons an overpriced piece of bread. White truffles are valued for their powerful yet extraordinarily delicate aroma, and production is extremely limited. This delicacy is grown in the Alba region of Italy beneath certain oak trees. Trained dogs or pigs are necessary to locate these truffles, which are in season from late autumn to winter. The goji berries used in the Riesling jelly are the richest known source of beta-carotene of all known foods or plants on earth, and are demonstrated to be a healing catalyst. Timed with the limited seasonal window, the **\$1,000 bagel** will be available from November 1 to December 15, 2017.

Considering how pricing has risen in the past decade (try buying an apartment for the same price as it was in 2007), this bagel at its introductory cost is nearly a deal. For those who can't

get to New York for this year, this extravagant bagel could possibly make an encore appearance during the next truffle season.

When the bagel was first launched there was a focus on a do-good component and not just good ingredients. This time around is no different. Knowing that items carrying tremendous price tags often spark some criticism (why so much?!), all of the bagel sales will benefit Holy Apostles Soup Kitchen.

Guests might like to compliment the bagel with a shot of Pappy Van Winkle bourbon that the hotel is serving (bottle #299 of the only 710 bottles produced). A half-ounce pour is \$175, while a full ounce goes for \$315. Only 11 barrels were gracefully aged for a quarter century to create this once-in-a-lifetime spirt. The 25-year-old Pappy Van Winkle bourbon, which many say "has been released in quantities so limited that most of us have no hope of seeing," began being poured at The Westin New York at Times Square's Foundry Bar in late June.
